You may have already seen or heard the news but I wanted to share this with all of you.

Nine Massachusetts cities and towns have adopted the Nicotine Free Generation tobacco prevention policy.

The celebration at the State House earlier this week culminated with the announcement that three of our State Legislators intend to file a bill in January that will prohibit the sale of nicotine products to those born after a certain birthdate.

This is a heavy lift and we need to keep the momentum going. We'll be working hard to introduce NFG to additional communities in the weeks and months ahead. Thank you all for your help getting us to this point. This only happened because of people you who were willing to stand up and say no to Big Tobacco.

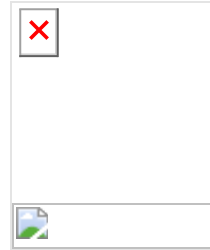
